Implementation of the Open Government Information and Data Programme: Report-back on Agency Progress

Portfolio Land Information

On 2 December 2015, the Cabinet Committee on State Sector Reform and Expenditure Control:

- 1 **noted** that the New Zealand Open Government Information and Data 2015 Progress Report describes agencies' progress in releasing public information and data for re-use, and the known impacts of the re-use;
- 2 **noted** that increased use of public data by the private sector and civil society is contributing to increased business activity and public engagement;
- 3 **noted** that the regular release of public data is not yet business as usual across central government and that work across the broader public sector is embryonic;
- 4 **noted** that the Chair of the Open Government Data Chief Executives' Governance Group intends to release the 2015 New Zealand Open Government Information and Data: 2015 Progress Report and the raw report data;
- 5 **noted** that the Minister for Land Information proposes to publish the submission under SEC-15-MIN-0034 on the ict.govt.nz website.
